BY TRAIN

Located 2 miles away from the stadium is Leeds' main train station, Leeds Railway Station. Leeds Railway Station is just a five minute walk from Leeds City Centre and served by direct lines from London, Newcastle, Manchester, Liverpool, Edinburgh and more! SHUTTLE BUS

From Sovereign Street, a matchday shuttle bus service (R2) will run until kick-off. Tickets cost £3.00 return for adults and £1.50 for concessions. This will run from 3 hours before kick off.

WALKING ROUTE

The walk from Leeds Railway Station takes approximately 25 minutes. The route is newly refurbished and well lit. Detailed directions can be found on the website at www.leedsunited.com

CAR PARKING

While no parking is available at Elland Road, many local car parks operate on a first-come, first-served basis. Keep in mind that car park charges are cash only.

The car parks at Leeds City Council Car Park A&B and Elland Road offer over 2,000 spaces between them and all three are within a 7-minute walk of the venue.

There is also the PR car park available at £6 per car.

Fireworks, flares or smoke cannisters

Glass bottles and cans



Plastic bottles over 100ml (water prohibited)



Professional photography equipment/drones

Smoking is not permitted inside the venue, including e-cigarettes.

Please note that there may be loud noises, flashing lights and fireworks during or before RLWC2021 fixtures.

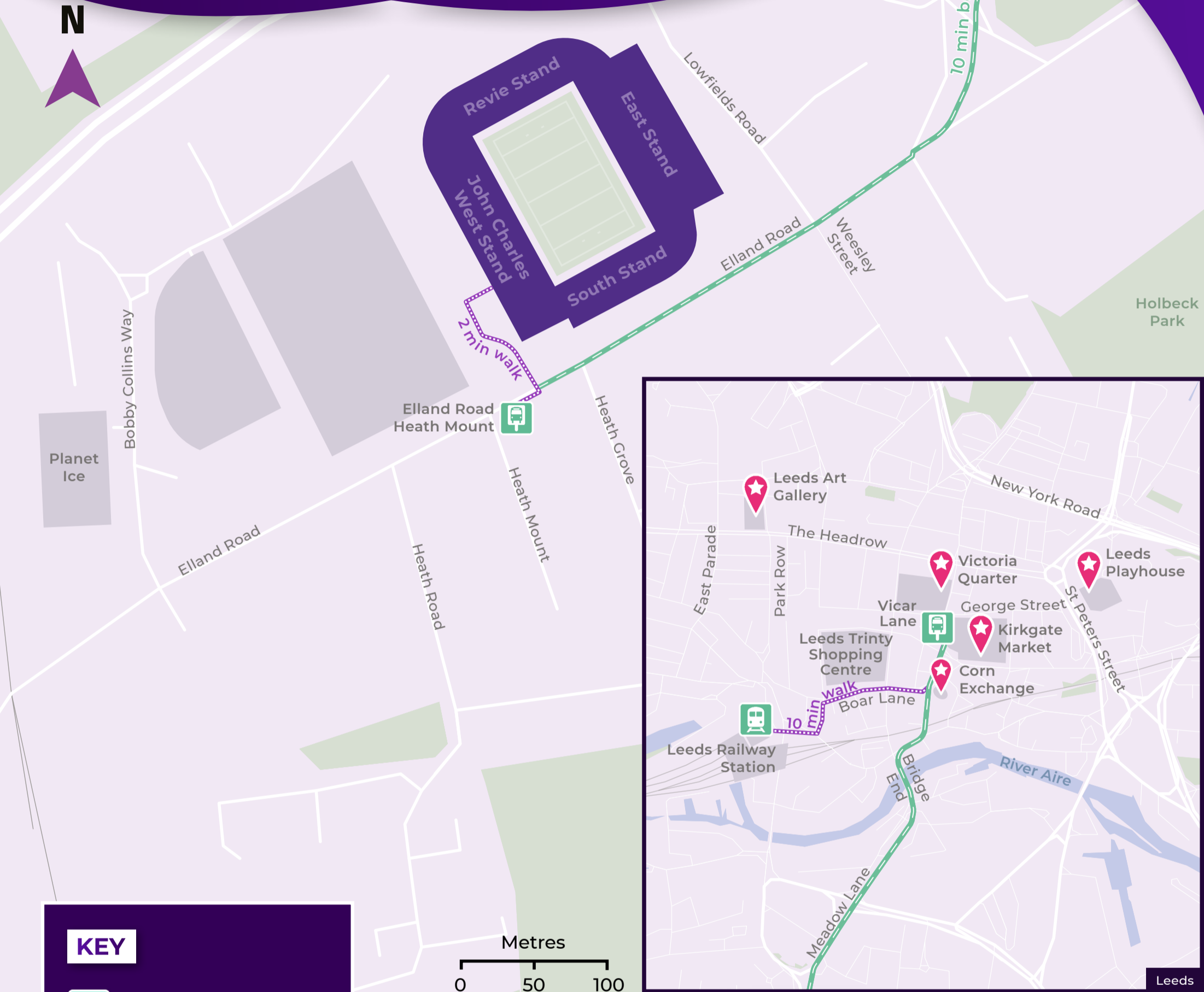

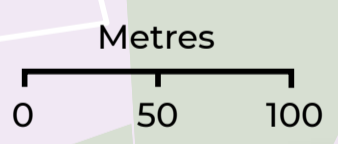
