PLAN YOUR TRIP

BY TRAIN

Burley Park Station

Burley Park Station is on the Harrogate Line and is a five minute walk from the ground. Trains run half hourly and should take around five minutes. If travelling from Leeds City Station this is your recommended station to use.

Headingley Station

Headingley Station is around a 10-15 minute drive from Leeds City Station. It is also on the Harrogate Line and is a 10 minute walk from the ground. Please note that the initial part of this walk is slightly uphill. Trains run half-hourly from Leeds City Station and should take around 12 minutes.

WALKING ROUTE

The walk from Burley Park Station takes approximately 8 minutes. and the walk from Headingley Station takes approximately 13 minutes. Please see the map, or use our journey planner, to plan your route.




